Essay Question: What is the housing crisis that is occurring right now for Puerto Ricans living in the Puerto Rican archipelago?

Note: The Puerto Rican island archipelago refers to all the islands of Puerto Rico: Puerto Rico, Culebra, Vieques, etc. CLICK HERE TO LEARN MORE!

Discussion Points:

- Why are Americans (not of Puerto Rican descent) moving to the islands of Puerto Rico?
- What has been happening regarding real estate development in the Puerto Rican archipelago and the privatization of public beaches?
- Include how this financially impacts the Puerto Ricans living in the islands of Puerto Rico.
- Discuss the <u>cultural</u> and <u>environmental</u> impacts of this crisis.

ESSAY REQUIREMENTS

- Typed on a separate sheet of paper.
- PART A: Introduction 3-5 sentence requirement.
- PART B: Essay must be a minimum 250 words.
- Double spaced.
- 12 point font (Times New Roman, Georgia, or Palatino).

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2023 Enclosure Requirements and Recommendation Letter

- <u>Completed Application</u> (may use additional sheets of paper to answer)
- Official Transcripts. Transcripts must be received by <u>November 11, 2023</u>. They may be mailed directly from your school or enclosed with application. If transcripts are mailed by the student with scholarship application, transcripts must be sealed with a school logo.
- Proof of **full-time enrollment** at your college, university, trade/technical school.
- 1 sealed <u>Letter of Recommendation</u> from one the following: Professor/Teacher, Dean/School Principal, School Counselor, Volunteer Coordinator, Faith Leader, Current or Past Employer. Letter may be mailed directly from source or enclosed with application. <u>Recommendation letter must be received by application deadline of November 11, 2023.</u>
